

Year 2 Curriculum Forecast Summer Term



Writing

As writers, we will be using the book Supertato as inspiration. We will be writing narrative stories using an overcoming the monster plot to tell stories about superheroes. We will also be writing non-chronological reports about superheroes.

As readers, we will be using the text Fantastic Mr Fox by Roald Dahl to explore characters using a range of retrieval and inference skills. We will also be exploring a non-fiction text about foxes and the poem Colour by Christina Rossetti.

Reading

Maths

As mathematicians, we will start our term learning about fractions, recognising and finding a half, quarter, third and three quarters of shapes and amounts. We will also learn to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes, as well as exploring position and direction.

Science

As scientists, we will be learning about plants. We will learn about what plants need to grow; seeds and how they grow into mature plants; and explore how plants grow in different habitats and climates.

History

As historians, we will be learning about travel in the past. We will explore a range of different types of travel including George Stephenson's first steam train, Karl Benz and the first car, the Wright brothers and the first flight, and the moon landings. We will learn about significant individuals throughout history and the impact their discoveries had on transport today.

Geography

As geographers, we will be carrying out a local study on Hunsbury. We will use compass directions and directional language to navigate around our school as well as the local area. We will identify different human and physical features in the area, as well as identifying different styles of houses. We will also look at the land use around our school and local area.

Design and Technology

As designers, we will be exploring textiles and will be developing and using sewing skills to design and make a space badge. To ensure this fits our purpose, we will make sure to consider the design, colours, materials, and joining techniques needed. We will practise the cutting and sewing skills needed before we create our final piece and will evaluate them against a design criteria.

Art and Design

As artists, we will be exploring sculpture. We will look at and recreate a sculpture from our local area using clay. We will also go on to design and make a sculpture showing something important to us.

PSHE

As responsible citizens, we will be learning about healthy relationships in term 5 and in term 6 will move onto looking at how children change from babies to adults, as well as physical differences between boys and girls.

RE

As respectful learners, we will learn about the concept of God and what this might mean for Christians. We will also learn about the Hindu festival of Raksha Bandhan.

Computing

As computer scientists, we will be learning about animation using technology and how to use computers to create quizzes. We will also discuss responsible use of technology and how to make smart choices.

Music

As musicians, children will explore pitch, rhythm and sound, and will have a weekly lesson learning the ukulele this term delivered by Mrs Hayes. They will get to practise and play this instrument as a class.

PΕ

As sportspeople, we will be developing our coordination, teamwork and basic ball skills. We will also focus on developing our health and fitness during games and physical activities.
